#### **Context and Justification**

It is believed that the strong economic growth of Angola in the last years<sup>1</sup> has been accompanied by significant improvements in economic and social conditions of its citizens. This is true, particularly given the massive reconstruction programs, largely financed by the Government whose achievements are noticeable across many spheres of the economy.

To help give a snapshot of the impact of this strong economic growth, and have a quick measure of the impact of the Global Economic crisis in the prosecution of the MDGs, UNDP will support Angolan Government to produce its 3rd MFG Report; along with analytical studies on related topics. It is expected that the production of the MDG Report and implementation of related activities, herein referred to as MDGR, will last 12 months, starting late October with a Launching Workshop expected to be held on January 2010 and be finalized at the same year. The MDGR process will help mobilize synergies around the achievement of MDGs by 2015.

With basically 5 years to go for the attainment of the MDG, one expects that this 3rd national reporting process to contribute to encourage debates and center-staging the MDGs in the framework of the National Program of Development production as well as trigger more and faster delivery of commitments from Government, CSO and Donors.

The current Work Plan aims to orient the MDG reporting process with the following major deliverables:

1. Production and launching of the 3rd MDG Report;

2. Support upstream pro-poor policy formulation and MDG based planning so that MDGs be fully integrated in the national planning process;

3. The capacity building to monitor the efforts towards MDGs achievement. This includes the provision of support for undertaking analytical studies on related topics;

4. The strengthening of Government capacity for coordination, management and harmonization of external support, reducing transaction costs and increasing levels of efficiency in its use;

5. The building of organizational capacity of CSO to play a more proactive role in the development discourse, through their participation in poverty policy evaluations, service delivery and in the analysis of the proposed plans and data monitoring at central and provincial levels;

6. The strengthening of national statistical capacity, especially to better inform on human and MDGs development, through needs assessment and implementation of a Capacity Development strategy at National Statistics System.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> GDP grew at about 20 per cent over the last three years, Angola ranks among the fastest-growing economies in the world. The growth rate slowed to an estimated 15.8 per cent in 2008 and is expected to turn negative in 2009 before rebounding in 2010. (African Economic Outlook, 2009)
