Senhora CEO,

A Direcção Geral dos Recursos Hídricos, gostaria de vos comunicar a sua aceitação do Documento de Projecto « Reforço de capacidade de adaptação e resiliência às mudanças climáticas nos sectores agrário e hídrico na Guiné-Bissau ».

Nós temos a honra de vos confirmar, pela presente, que no quadro do Programa Sub-regional de luta contra a pobreza através do melhoramento do acesso à água potável a favor das populações mais vulneráveis, o Governo da Guiné-Bissau tem recebido, enquanto membro da UEMOA (União Económica e Monetária Oeste Africana) e da OMVG (Organização para a valorização do rio Gâmbia, um financiamento total de 3.912.530.471 Xof (Três biliões, novecentos e doze milhões, quinhentos e trinta mil quatrocentos e setenta e um francos), equivalente a 5.964.614.25 Euros (Cinco milhões, novecentos sessenta e quatro mil, seiscentos e catorze francos e vinte e cinco centavos de Euros) ou 8.823.392,41 \$USD para a execução dos projectos abaixo:

- **Programa de hidráulica rural da UEMOA na Guiné-Bissau**, de 2.729.840.000 Xof, para o período de 2009-2011. No total 300 pontos de água são previstos construir, e para a Região de Gabú um total de 50 pontos de água, ainda um programa de reforço de capacidade das comunidades em gestão auto-sustentada de pontos de água, incluindo sensibilização e educação em higiene e saneamento básico.
- **Projecto de gestão integrada dos recursos em água nas bacias hidrográficas do rio Kayanga-Geba**, de 1.182.690.471 Xof financiado, a título de subvenção, no quadro de *Facilité Africain de L'Eau*, para o período de 2010-2012. Está previsto afectar, no âmbito deste projecto um montante de 792,300 Euros para a elaboração do Plano de Gestão Integrada dos Recursos Hídricos desta bacia (componente 1) assim como o financiamento de estudos para a exploração hidroagrícola dos recursos em água na sua parte à jusante na Guiné-Bissau (componente 2). Esta bacia está situada nos sítios escolhidos para a intervenção do projecto PNUD/GEF.

Madam the CEO,

The General Directorate for Water Resources is pleased to inform its acceptance of the Project Document for the project “Strengthening adaptive capacity and resilience to Climate Change in the Agrarian and Water Resources Sectors in Guinea-Bissau”.

We are honoured to confirm through this letter that, within the framework of the Sub-Regional Programme to Fight against Poverty, the Government of Guinea-Bissau has been receiving, as a member of UEMOA (the West African Monetary Union) and from OMVG (the Basin Organisation for the Management of the Gambia River) a total finance of 3,912,530,471 XOF (three billion nine hundred and twelve million, five hundred and thirty thousand and four hundred seventy one francs), equivalent to 5,964,614.25 Euros (five million nine hundred and sixty four thousand Euros and twenty five cents), that is 8,823,392.41 USD for the execution of the following projects:

- **UEMOA's Rural Hydraulics Programme in Guinea-Bissau**, of 2,729,840,000 XOF for the period 2009-2011. In total 300 water points are foreseen to be built, and for the Gabú Region, a total of 50 water points, plus a community capacity strengthening programme on self-sustained water point management, including sensitization and training in hygiene and basic sewerage.
- **Integrated water resource management for the hydrographical basins of river Kayanga-Geba**, of 1,182,609,417 XOF financed as a grant, within the framework of African Water Facility for the period 2010-2012. It is foreseen that in the realm of this project, an amount of 792,300 Euros will be used for the preparation of an Integrated Water Management Plan for this basin (component 1), as well as the financing of studies for the exploration of basin's irrigation potential with respect to the part of the river that flows into Guinea-Bissau. This basin is located in the same sites selected for the UNDP/GEF intervention.

The resources allocated to these projects will be channelled to institutional and human capacity building, as well as to the building of water management infra-structure to the benefit of the [rural] populations, namely in the rural areas, where water scarcity is marked, such as in Pirada and Pitche, sites, as previously mentioned, selected for the UNDP/GEF project.

Activities to be implemented by these two above-mentioned on-going projects will concur to the objectives of strengthening the adaptive capacity and resilience to climate change in the agrarian and water sectors.




