between the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Belarus and the United Nations Development Programme on the extension of the implementation period of the international technical assistance project "Assisting the Government of the Republic of Belarus in Accession to the World Trade Organization through Strengthening National Institutional Capacity and Expertise"

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Belarus and the United Nations Development Programme (hereinafter referred to as "Parties"),

Implementing the international technical assistance project "Assisting the Government of the Republic of Belarus in Accession to the World Trade Organization through Strengthening National Institutional Capacity and Expertise", registered on 01.03.2008 No. 2/08/000361 in the database of technical assistance programmes and projects (hereinafter referred to as "Project");

Considering the accession of the Republic of Belarus to the World Trade Organization is a tool to accelerate its integration into the multilateral trading system as well as optimize foreign trade structure and is a value added incentive to the economic development of the Republic of Belarus:

Considering the implementation of the Project aims to implement paragraphs 4 and 5 of the Memorandum of Understanding on Accession to the World Trade Organization signed by the Heads of the Republic of Belarus and of the Russian Federation on 19 December 2011 in Moscow;

Based on the outcomes of the first, second, third and fourth phases of the Project;

In compliance with the need for sustainable and effective assistance to the Government of the Republic of Belarus in accession to the World Trade Organization;

Agreed as follows:

- 1. Parties extend the implementation period of the Project in a format of the fifth phase till 31 December 2020 with no changes to Project goal and objectives stated in the Project Document.
- 2. The Government of the Russian Federation (hereinafter referred to as "Project Donor") finances the fifth phase of the Project to the total amount of USD 592,503. This amount also includes the costs of services provided by UNDP country office as a part of the Project Budget.

- 3. The UNDP country office may provide support services for the implementation of Project activities in accordance with the Project work plan and Annex 1 attached to the current Memorandum.
- 4. The fifth phase of the Project is implemented in line with the Project Document, the current Memorandum with its Annex 1, and attached Budget of the fifth phase of the Project.
- 5. UNDP services mentioned in para. 3 of the current Memorandum will be covered solely from respective Project Budget lines and according to the Project work plan. In case the terms of the services provision are amended by mutual agreement of UNDP and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Belarus during the project implementation correspondent amendments shall be made to Project work plan and Budget. In case of substantive amendments to the Project work plan and Budget, they should be approved by the Project Donor.
