Dear Mrs Mermet

Reference is made to the Grant Confirmation dated 11 December 2019 (as amended from time to time, the "**Grant Confirmation**") between the Global Fund to Fight AIDS, Tuberculosis and Malaria (the "**Global Fund**") and the United Nations Development Programme (the "**Principal Recipient**") for grant BOL-T-UNDP (the "**Grant**"). Unless defined in this Implementation Letter or the context otherwise requires, all capitalized terms used in this letter have the same meaning set out in the Grant Confirmation.

We refer to Article 3 of the UNDP-Global Fund Grant Regulations which provides that the "Grant" consists of "funds as stated in the relevant Grant Confirmation together with any funds previously granted by the Global Fund to the Principal Recipient for the Program." Where the Global Fund approves the use under the current Grant Confirmation of grant funds disbursed to the Principal Recipient under a previous Grant Agreement for the Program ("Previously Disbursed Grant Funds"), the Global Fund may reduce the amount of Grant Funds set forth in Section 3.6 of the Grant Confirmation by the amount of any Previously Disbursed Grant Funds.

The amount of Previously Disbursed Grant Funds is **US\$ 824'193**. The Global Fund is therefore reducing the amount of Grant Funds set out in Section 3.6 of the Grant Confirmation by the Previously Disbursed Grant Funds. For the avoidance of doubt, (a) the definition of "Grant Funds" set forth in Section 1.2 of the UNDP-Global Fund Grant Regulations shall include the Previously Disbursed Grant Funds; and (b) the reduction of Grant Funds in Section 3.6 of the Grant Confirmation by the Previously Disbursed Grant Funds; and (b) the reduction of Grant Funds in Section 3.6 of the Grant Confirmation by the Previously Disbursed Grant Funds does not affect the Program budget.

In addition, the Global Fund has approved additional funding for **US\$ 455'236** for COVID-19 support. As a result, this letter reduces Grant Funds for the Implementation Period by **US\$ 368'957.** This letter also amends the Summary Budget included in Schedule I (Integrated Grant Description) of the Grant Confirmation.

In addition, following the appointment of the new Regional Manager, we are modifying the contact details of the Global Fund.

Accordingly, we propose making the following changes to the Grant Confirmation:

- 1. Section 3 of the Grant Confirmation is hereby deleted and replaced with the revised Section 3 annexed to this letter.
- 2. The Summary Budget is hereby deleted and replaced with the revised Summary Budget annexed to this letter.
- 3. The following requirement will now be included at section 4 in the Grant Confirmation:

In accordance with the Global Fund Board Decision on additional support for country responses to COVID-19 (GF/B42/EDP11), the Program budget includes **US\$ 455'236** in funding granted under the Global Fund COVID-19 Response Mechanism ("C19RM Funds") programmed towards activities to respond to the COVID-19 pandemic ("Approved C19RM Activities"). Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the Grant Agreement, C19RM Funds must remain invested in the Approved C19RM Activities and may only be reprogrammed or carried over to a subsequent Implementation Period upon prior written approval by the Global Fund, provided that in no event shall C19RM Funds be used later than 30 June 2021, unless otherwise agreed in writing by the Global Fund.

Other than as modified by this letter, all provisions of the Grant Agreement remain the same.

Please confirm your agreement to the amendments herein by signing this letter and returning a copy to the Global Fund by electronic messaging system. These amendments will be effective upon the signing of this letter by an authorized representative of the Global Fund Finance Division and a fully executed electronic copy of this letter will be sent to you for your records.

Thank you for your important efforts in the global fight against tuberculosis. We look forward to the continued successful implementation of the Program.
