I am pleased to inform you that the Administrator has approved the amount of \$267,500 (two hundred and sixty seven thousand five hundred) to support the response to the impact of COVID-19 in Bolivia in accordance with the COVID-19 Rapid Response Facility (RRF) guidelines.

The funding will be made available from the UNDP Funding Window for Governance, Conflict Prevention and Resilience, sub-window on Crisis Response (ATLAS fund code 28641; donor code 12711). An authorized spending limit (ASL) of \$100,000 will be established once you provide a valid output number, and the balance of funding will be released based on resource utilization progress. Please note, to facilitate the monitoring and reporting of resources dedicated to COVID-19, you are asked to create a new output under an existing project. In accordance with the directives of UNDP's Executive Board, please apply a General Management Support (GMS) rate of 7%.

Kindly note that the implementation of this allocation must strictly adhere to the established corporate policies and procedures as prescribed in the POPP. As the Head of the UNDP Country Office in Bolivia you will be held accountable for the effective and prudent use of the funds allocated to your office for the intended purposes. The planned project activities as presented in the proposal must be completed within 6 months of the allocation date.
