Título del Proyecto: Fortalecimiento a la Federación de Ganaderos del Beni para enfrentar la sequía, aumentar el acceso al agua y mejorar su producción para seguridad alimentaria; y el acceso al agua a comunidades indígena originario campesinas, urbanas y rurales.

Breve descripción

La Junta Directiva del Proyecto se reunió el 20 de noviembre de 2020 para evaluar el grado de avance de las actividades. A pesar de los esfuerzos del PNUD y FEGABENI, el cronograma de perforación de pozos no se pudo reiniciar debido a las estrictas medidas de cuarentena vigentes en Bolivia desde marzo de 2020, junto con un período de malestar político y social que se extendió desde octubre de 2019 hasta que se celebraron nuevas elecciones nacionales el 18 de octubre de 2020. Con la instalación de un nuevo gobierno, las actividades del proyecto se reanudaron gradual, aunque lentamente.

A la conclusión de la reunión, la Junta decidió solicitar al Directorio del Fondo IBSA una extensión sin costo hasta el 31 de agosto de 2021, y realizar una revisión sustantiva al Documento del Proyecto, considerando los aspectos detallados a continuación.

- El diseño del proyecto consideró la compra de tres plataformas de perforación de pozos, cada una de las cuales perforaría 40 pozos, totalizando una meta total de 120 pozos. Las especificaciones técnicas de las plataformas se reforzaron para dar respuesta a la solicitud de los beneficiarios de perforar pozos más profundos. Esto incrementó considerablemente el costo final de los equipos y, por este motivo, solo se pudieron comprar dos plataformas en lugar de tres, lo que redujo la meta total a 80 pozos.
- Las actividades del proyecto estuvieron paralizadas durante dos meses debido a los conflictos sociales y políticos generados luego de las elecciones nacionales de octubre de 2019, que desembocaron en una espiral de violencia que terminó con más de 30 personas fallecidas y sumió al país en meses de malestar político.
- Los equipos de perforación presentaron problemas técnicos durante la etapa inicial de configuración y operación, lo que retrasó el programa de perforación de pozos. Los equipos se sometieron a un mantenimiento general por cuenta del proveedor para resolver los problemas presentados y estuvieron listos para reiniciar la perforación en diciembre de 2019.
- Las temporadas anuales de lluvias (entre noviembre de 2019 y abril de 2020) redujeron el tiempo efectivo de perforación de pozos.
- La cuarentena general, decretada para evitar la expansión de la pandemia por la COVID-19, restringió las actividades a nivel nacional durante casi ocho meses (entre marzo y septiembre de 2020); las actividades se reiniciaron lentamente teniendo en cuenta la bioseguridad y las medidas de prevención para reducir el riesgo de contagio.
- No se cumplió el compromiso de los municipios de destinar fondos de contrapartida para cubrir los materiales requeridos para la perforación de 38 pozos para comunidades rurales y urbanas, por lo que el Proyecto decidió utilizar los recursos restantes para cubrir los materiales requeridos y subsidiar el costo para las comunidades más vulnerables, como directos beneficiarios.

Para cumplir con los objetivos del proyecto y hacerlo sostenible, FEGABENI ha establecido la



meta de perforar al menos dos pozos por mes por cada plataforma de perforación durante los próximos tres años, lo que conduciría a cumplir con el objetivo del proyecto originalmente establecido.

En general, esto resultaría en un total de 20 pozos excavados por el proyecto hasta agosto de 2021, a una tasa totalmente subsidiada para las comunidades más vulnerables e indígenas, y alrededor de 75 pozos excavados por el socio del proyecto FEGABENI, en paralelo o posteriormente, en parte a una tasa subvencionada de alrededor del 55% de los precios de mercado.

Por el impacto que la pandemia ha tenido en el departamento del Beni y de forma coincidente con los objetivos del Proyecto, se propone priorizar la perforación de pozos en las áreas, donde se registre la necesidad urgente de agua para la población e instalaciones de salud para contribuir de mejor manera en la lucha contra la COVID-19.
