High level event to present the SCORE to UNDP senior management	Organisation of High level round table discussion on SCORE with UNDP Assistant Administrator and Director of UNDP Regional Bureau on Friday 3 rd July 9-10.30 am at H4C	SeeD	June- July 2015	<p>The high-level round-table discussion entitled “<i>How can SCORE be used as a tool for conflict transformation and policy making in multi-ethnic societies?</i>” successfully took place on Friday, 3rd July 2015 at the Home for Cooperation (Nicosia, Ledra Palace Buffer Zone). The event was attended by Ms. Cihan Sultanoglu, the Assistant Administrator and Director of the UNDP Regional Bureau for Europe and CIS, and an exclusive group of prominent thought leaders in Cyprus.</p> <p>The discussion included reflections on some of the key findings from the SCORE Index Research conducted so far in Cyprus as well as Bosnia-Herzegovina, in relation to how different communities perceive social cohesion, reconciliation and political compromise.</p>

The participants were provided with SCORE Executive Report as well as the copy of the SCORE publication.</p>
2. SCORE Cyprus 2015 results rolled out in both communities	Organise a series of events to share the results and recommendations of SCORE Cyprus 2015 in Nicosia, Limassol and Famagusta	SeeD	Sept – Nov 2015	<p>The SCORE outreach events focused on informing the general public as well as the various stakeholders, while also aiming to spark an evidence-based dialogue on the policy recommendations.</p> <p>Following the consultation with UNDP-ACT, it was agreed to one public launch event in Nicosia district only. Instead of having mono-communal events in Limassol and Famagusta, it was agreed to hold inter-communal focus group meetings with specific target groups in order to maximize the impact of the SCORE outreach. In total, SeeD organized 4 inter-communal focus groups with the following identified groups:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a.) Politically affiliated youth: on 26th October 2015. b.) Women groups: on 2nd and 11th November 2015. c.) Human rights group (including grassroots organisations and CSOs which are involved in environment, education, research, active citizenship): on 9th November 2015. <p>During these focus group meetings the SCORE 2015 findings were presented, and the stakeholders were asked to make suggestions for policy recommendations based on the SCORE results. These policy recommendations were then compiled and incorporated by SeeD into the final SCORE publication.</p>

SCORE Cyprus 2015 results rolled out in both communities (continued)	Organise a series of events to share the results and recommendations of SCORE Cyprus 2015 in Nicosia, Limassol and Famagusta	SeeD	Sept – Nov 2015	<p>The SCORE Public Launch took place on 26th November at the Home for Cooperation (Nicosia, Ledra Palace Buffer Zone). Through this event, the SCORE findings were presented to relevant stakeholders (bi-communal activists, embassies’ representatives, international organisations in Cyprus, CSOs in Cyprus and academics). The presentation was followed by a public discussion moderated by Jasmine Kim-Westendorf, Lecturer at La Trobe University (elaborating on SCORE findings as an international expert). This event aimed to keep “natural allies” on board, approaching them both as receivers as well as multipliers of the messages. Event invitation was disseminated via emails and social media to reach out to the general public from both communities. In addition a press release (in English, Greek and Turkish) was issued following this event, in order to share the SCORE 2015 results with the society at large. The 2015 SCORE Index findings got wide media coverage from both communities.</p> <p>In addition, 4 high-level meetings & SCORE Presentations took place (or scheduled to take place):</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Presentation to the UN Special Adviser Espen Barth Eide and the UN Good Offices, on 4th November 2015 2) Presentation to the Greek-Turkish Forum (on 28th October, 2015) 3) Presentation to the White House Visitor Mark Schapiro, US National Security Council (on 19th November 2015) 4) Presentation to the US Ambassador Kathleen A. Doherty and the Embassy’s Political, Economic and Public Affairs sections (scheduled to take place on 7th December 2015)

Update SCORE publication	<p>Produce additional chapters on SCORE Cyprus 15 and Nepal 15</p> <p>Work with editor and designer to update the SCORE publication as a PDF file for upload onto the SCORE platform</p>	SeeD	Sept – Nov 2015	<p>The second edition of the SCORE Publication (including SCORE Cyprus Chapter 15 and the revised Bosnia Chapter) has been finalized and ready to be uploaded by 4th December (the SCORE Bosnia Chapter was revised based on the feedback received from the USAID - Bosnia).</p> <p>The draft Nepal 2015 Chapter (along with all the files for the online platform) has been submitted to UNDP-ACT on 1st December 2015. The final version of the Nepal Chapter will be published in early 2016, pending GIZ approval. In the meantime, the draft Nepal Chapter is to be edited and designed by the end of December 2015.</p> <p>Similarly, the data visualisation for Nepal is to be uploaded but not be visible to the public, by the end of December 2015.</p>
