This report outlines the main activities undertaken by ITA during the period from 1st January to 30th June 2016, under the technical assistance framework to the technical team of the Ministry of Commerce and Handicrafts, responsible for implementing the Enhanced Integrated Framework (EIF) project in Guinea Bissau.

| DTIS update process | The ITA gave his opinion, did an informal translation into Portuguese of part of the draft DTIS II and contributed to the coordination and supervision of the entire process. He supported the preparation of the national consultants' reports and the preparation of information and awareness meetings as part of the data collection and compilation process and submission to the National Implementation Unit (NIU) Coordinator for the preparation of the preliminary report. The ITA also participated in several meetings between the NIU, UNDP and Team Leader. |
| Creation of the Trade Forum | The ITA drafted and contributed to the approval of the decree establishing the Inter-agency Trade Coordinating Committee ¹ and submitted it to the Minister of Trade to be included in the agenda of the Council of Ministers. |
| Drafting and approval of the Guinea Bissau Trade Development Strategy | The ITA drafted and contributed to the approval process of the major policies of the trade strategy. He went on a mission to Bolama², promoted meetings with the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development, the Guinea Bissau office of the Organization for the Harmonization of Business Law in Africa (OHADA in Portuguese) and the private sector (Chamber of Commerce, Industry, Agriculture and Services, Association of Economic Activity of Women (AMAE), Association of Transporters (ASTRA) and National Farmers' Association (ANAG)) to present the major direction of the commercial strategy and collect additional information for the preparation of the preliminary report of the trade strategy. The ITA drafted and submitted to the NIU/EIF, the Preliminary Report of the Strategy for Trade Development and contributed to the discussion and internal approval. He completed and submitted to the NIU/EIF the Final Report Project of the Trade Development Strategy for internal consideration and approval and prepared the information gathering at the respective municipalities, with a view |
