### DESCRIPTION OF UNDP COUNTRY OFFICE SUPPORT SERVICES

UNDP will provide technical and operational support necessary for the implementation of activities and the results of this project. For services provided, UNDP will ensure compliance with UNDP standards and procedures. UNDP will provide advance payments to the project upon request, using the Funding Authorization and Cash Expenditure (FACE) form, or make direct payments upon request where The Ministry of Climate Resilience, The Environment, Forestry, Fisheries, Disaster Management and Information has completed the procurement in accordance with government policies and procedures and in compliance with rules and procedures contained in the National Implementation Manual.

UNDP will administer funds provided by the Global Environmental Facility, having final fiduciary responsibility. UNDP will be able to assist in the management of any other additional fund for co-financing this project which may be acquired.
