RE: Zimbabwe Allocation from Rapid Financing Facility in support of the UNDP *Beyond Recovery* COVID-19 Offer

Dear Mr. van Montfort,

I am pleased to inform you that the Administrator has approved the amount of \$1,500,000 (one million five hundred) to support the recovery efforts of Zimbabwe in line with the UNDP Covid 2.0 programme priorities, and in accordance with the Rapid Financing Facility (RFF) guidelines.

The funding will be made available from UNDP corporate resources (ATLAS fund code 04001; donor code 0012). Authorized spending limits (ASLs) will be established in Atlas once you provide a valid output number, as instructed below. To facilitate the monitoring of the RFF resources, please establish a new output under an existing or a new project. You can choose the most appropriate project delivery instrument, including Engagement Facility and Project Initiation Plan. GMS is not applicable to this funding.

After 24 hours of creating the new output in Atlas, please tag the COVID-19 Marker accurately <u>here</u> for effective monitoring and reporting on RFF funded projects. The guidance note on COVID-19 Marker can be found <u>here</u>. Monitoring of RFF funded projects will be conducted using the COVID-19 Monitoring Dashboard, which draws live data from the COVID-19 Marker and Atlas. Reporting will be streamlined into the COVID-19 reporting exercise using the mini-ROAR and COVID-19 indicators. Delivery updates may be requested through your Regional Bureaus, on a quarterly basis.

Kindly note that the implementation of this allocation must strictly adhere to the established corporate policies and procedures as prescribed in the POPP. The UNDP Resident Representative in Zimbabwe is responsible for the effective and prudent use of the funds allocated to your office for the intended purposes. The planned project activities as presented in the proposal must start within six weeks (as shown in Atlas expenditure) and be completed within 18 months after the date of this allocation letter.
