This project is the UNDP component of the multi-agency the Partnership for Action on Green Economy (PAGE) initiative. Since the start of its activities in 2013, PAGE has evolved from a small, coordinated effort involving five United Nations agencies into a growing partnership supported by eight funding partners. UN PAGE brings together the expertise of ILO, UNDP, UNEP, UNIDO and UNITAR who work jointly in supporting countries to reframe macroeconomic and sectoral policies around sustainability. To date, PAGE has been active in 20 partner countries, and inspired action in a further 90 countries. In the decade 2020-2030, UN PAGE plans to build on this momentum by expanding and deepening its engagement with 10 additional countries and with regional organizations.

With the demand for the project continuing to grow, the UNDP project under PAGE has been extended for a period of four additional years from January 1, 2021 to December 31, 2024. The substantive outputs remain unchanged. Management arrangements commensurate with the needs of the programme will be put in place, including recruitment of professional project staff(s). Additional funds received will cover the expanded work under the existing outputs.

¹ The PAGE governance structure includes a Management Board (MB) with Director-level representation of all five PAGE agencies, as well as a Steering Committee (SC) which includes PAGE funding partners and MB members. The UNDP PAGE pro doc is being extended without substantive changes to its planned outputs. The strategic focus of the period covered by the pro doc extension is described in a high-level PAGE Strategy 2030, that was approved by the PAGE MB and Steering Committee in 2020. The PAGE MB, and a Technical Team with representatives from each Agency, meets quarterly and more frequently on an ad hoc basis. Each PAGE agency has prepared its own pro doc in line with agency requirements. UNDP Bureaus are updated on a regular basis on all PAGE activities including through a monthly PAGE newsletter. For these reasons a formal Project Board meeting and new PAC were not required to extend the PAGE project for an additional four years. UNDP will prepare an internal update on PAGE activities in Q1 2021.

² PAGE resources are allocated on a rolling basis to each PAGE agency depending on country needs and realization of donor pledges, which are made at different times each year. Total allocated resources are an estimate of funds committed to UNDP for 2021. There is an expectation that additional donor funds will be allocated to UNDP for 2022-2024. PAGE is also developing a new RM strategy.
