- Today, we are gathered here to receive a consignment of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE), which is a donation from your esteemed organization, UNDP.
- This support is anchored on the partnership framework between UNDP and EACC in strengthening **Public Sector Accountability.** I am pleased to note that UNDP has committed approximately **Kshs. 85 Million** toward this noble Programme.
- Under the Programme, the other areas of collaborations, a part from Health and Safety will include:
 - i) Media outreach to sensitize citizens and empower them to proactively participate in governance processes; and
 - ii) Strengthening policy and legal frameworks for combating and preventing corruption.

- I am pleased to confirm that today, the Commission has received the first consignment of Personal Protective Equipment (PPEs) worth approximately **Kshs. 9 Million.** I am also aware that acquisition of ICT related items is at an advanced stage. I hope that we will have a similar occasion soon.
- The PPE that we are receiving today, include; hand sanitizers, face shields, disposable surgical face masks, re-usable face masks, digital thermo- guns and hand gloves.
- All these items are critical to safeguard the health, safety and well-being of our approx.
 750 employees and hundreds of clients who visit EACC offices and Huduma Service Desks across the Country.
- The Equipment will facilitate business continuity as we re-align our programs to meet the current need by supporting the health sector and county governments to promote accountability particularly during the COVID – 19 period.
