

**TRANSFER OF TITLE OF VEHICLE FROM
THE UNITED NATIONS DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME
TO THE URAIA TRUST.**

THIS AGREEMENT made on 10th Day of July 2012, by and between the United Nations Development Programme (hereinafter referred to as "UNDP"), for the transfer to and the URAIA TRUST (hereinafter referred to as the "URAIA"), accepts full title and ownership of the vehicle Toyota Land cruiser previously registered as 40UNN88K and valued at a total cost of kes. 3,710,000 (Three Million, Seven Hundred and Ten thousand Shillings Only.

The vehicle transferred represent assistance of UNDP to URAIA TRUST to facilitate national Civic Education phase II, (hereinafter referred to as "Project"), undertaken in Kenya. The transfer of title is limited to the use of such vehicle solely for the stated purposes of the Project in the manner and place as set out in the Project Document and subject to further limitations contained therein.

The transfer of such vehicle must be affected in compliance with UNDP Financial Rules and Regulations, the Procurement Manual and the Asset Management Guidelines.


