# B ACHIEVEMENTS REPORT DURING THIS PERIOD

- UNDP / SCPD / DAI training programme : (ongoing)
  - During the month of December the PM was involved, with DAI sr. staff and the UNDP office in arranging the visit of the selected candidates.
  - The 3 selected profiles are expected to join DAI in the beginning of 2014.
  - Meanwhile the two remaining positions are currently re-opened and they will go under a second phase of evaluation. A good number of candidates are responding to the call. The profile evaluation process is expected to be finalized in early January.
  - During the month of December the PM prepared all the documentation to close the project year: annual report, quarterly report. The PM also started the evaluation for the expert S. Budden's contract renewal. Moreover a meeting was held with DAI seniors to start organizing the 2014 annual work plan. The general guidelines for 2014 will be discussed again in further meetings planned in the second half of December, in order to meet DAI expectations. The AWP will be delivered in early January.
- New research & exhibition project MAK (ongoing)
  - The preparatory research for the new exhibition is currently ongoing and the collected information is shaping up a deep investigation on the subject.
  - The exhibition and publication subject will be Modernist Architecture in Kuwait (MAK), and the PM/expert is the research coordinator of a broader team.
  - The research team paid visit to the Centre for Research & Studies on Kuwait (CRSK) and established a fruitful relation in order to exchange knowledge and information. The Center has a vast collection of documents pertaining to the subject of the research. The PM and the research team are currently investigating this archive and its potentiality.
  - Several other local institutions are shortlisted and they will be contacted soon in order to involve them in the research process
  - A completely new database system is been implemented with the help of DAI IT department. This database is collecting all the information, the references and the images coming out from the research project. This database will be the main source for the exhibition and the catalogue.
- Maintenance plan for the A.C.C. (ongoing)
  - In coordination with DAI senior staff several meeting were taken to achieve the necessary adjustment to the ACC galleries. A new survey was done on the electrical system of the building and the contractor submitted a proposal. The DAI directors have to approve the quotation in order to execute the works.

- Refurbishing project for al-Maidan Theatre. (ongoing)
  - The contractor is still currently working on the site but it is close to complete the job. All the major services were installed in the false ceiling as well as the panels and the lighting features. A final test of the lighting system is planned together with the contractor before the release of the final payment and the closing of works. The new stage is expected to be fully functional for the beginning of the new year.
- Side events at ACC: Carnival al Khayal (ongoing)
  - Carnival al-Khayal is a creative problem-solving workshop involving teams of high school students. Team members work together to resolve a predefined challenge and present their solution at the officially sanctioned Carnival al-Khayal. Challenges fall into five general categories: 1) mechanical, 2) classical, 3) structural 4) simulation and 5) technical.
  - DAI media team is currently organizing this event at ACC involving five high schools in the country. The event is planned for the second half of January 2014.

The PM has been involved to advise and supervise the structural challenge. A presentation /orientation meeting was held at the ACC with all the teachers and students in order to set the goals for the upcoming event.
