

Extension of the United Nations and Government of Liberia (GOL) Joint Programme on Food Security and Nutrition (JP FS&N)

In response to the Global Food Crisis and medium-term priorities in the National Poverty Reduction Strategy (PRS), the Government of Liberia and the United Nations developed a Joint Programme on Food Security and Nutrition (JP FS&N). Six United Nations Organizations (FAO, UNDP, UNICEF, UN WOMEN, WHO & WFP) and Government Counterparts signed the JP FS&N document on 13 June 2008.

The Joint Programme is aligned with the time-frame of the national Poverty Reduction Strategy (PRS) 2008- 2011. Given that the UN Development Assistance Framework (UNDAF 2008-2012) will only end in December 2012, and a new PRS will be launched in July 2012, participating UN Organizations and Government Counterparts decided to extend the JP until December 2012.

Accordingly, the JP and all related documents including the work plan were revised in May 2011.
