The Dry Zone is one of the most climate sensitive and natural resource poor regions in Myanmar and vulnerable to growing food insecurity and severe environmental degradation. The objective of the proposed project is to reduce the vulnerability of farmers in Myanmar's Dry Zone to increasing drought and rainfall variability, and enhance the capacity of farmers to plan for and respond to future impacts of Climate Change on food security. The proposed project is addressing climate risk resilience through community based and community driven adaptation in decentralized settings.
