#### Brief Description

While Mozambique has ratified most international and regional human rights instruments and mechanism that define the human rights normative standards, the implementation of these on the ground remains limited. Advocacy for policy and law reforms to bring the national legal framework in line with international best practices in promoting and protecting human rights is necessary. Additionally, human rights related to most vulnerable groups and minorities such as women, children, and people with disabilities, sexual minorities, albinos, prisoners and local communities have largely remained unrealized.

Following the II Cycle UPR to the Government of Mozambique in January 2016, Ministry of Justice, Constitutional and Religious Affairs is in process of drafting the new National Action Plan for the implementation of the II Cycle UPR recommendations for the period 2017-2020 as well as the Human Rights National Plan of Action. While the UPR is basically a State led initiative, through this process CSOs are provided with a crucial and seemingly rare opportunity to directly convene and cooperate with the government on pressing human rights issues.

The Project is formulated to improve the implementation of UPR recommendations by the Mozambican Government, through both strengthening of the capacities of the platform of CSOs to, monitor the implementation of the recommendations accepted and adopted by the Government of Mozambique during the 2<sup>nd</sup> Cycle of the UPR mechanism, and engage constructively with the Government to advocate for increased Government commitment for respecting its human rights obligations. The project logic is based on the assumption that once the civil society has the adequate tools and capacities, including enabling regulatory framework in place, it will lead to improved UPR implementation by the Government due to increased follow-up and pressure by the civil society.

The theory of change coupled with UNDP's experience working in the field, lessons learnt from the first UPR cycle and strategic approach of aligning with Government policy documents, has suggested the following interlinked project outputs: a) Improved coordination of Civil Society and Government's work towards implementation of the recommendations of the second UPR cycle; b) Civil society is empowered to effectively follow up the human rights situation in the country; c) Voices from the communities are consistently brought to national and international human rights fora by civil society
