Budget item 1.2.4 'Business Licensing Act Regulations' reduced from US\$ 10,000 to US\$ 7,000;

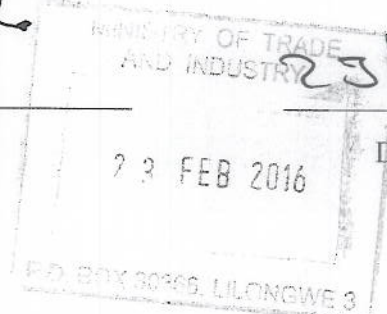
Budget item 1.2.6 'EPZ Regulations' reduced from US\$ 10,000 to US\$ 8,000;
