**RE: REQUEST OF PROJECT EXTENSION – COST SHARING AGREEMENT “SUPPORT TO MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES (MOHSS) FOR ACCELERATED IMPLEMENTATION OF GFATM GRANTS”.**

The abovementioned project has the overall objective of engaging the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) to support the Ministry of Health and Social Services in the implementation of Global Fund grants in Namibia.

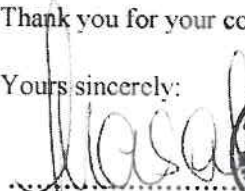
The project is designed to provide additional human resources and other support to MoHSS to address some of the critical gaps in implementing key Global Fund supported activities. The complete scope of work is detailed in the Cost Sharing Agreement and Project Document signed with the MoHSS (please refer to annexes 1 and 2).

The project, which is supporting Namibia's first tuberculosis (TB) prevalence survey, is ending on 30<sup>th</sup> June 2018. Based on current progress and recommendations by the technical partners supporting the survey, however, data analysis and report writing for the survey are only expected to conclude in September 2018.

It is against this background that we are requesting your good office to extend the project to 30<sup>th</sup> September 2018. The extension will facilitate retention of survey staff critical for data analysis and report writing. The envisaged cost of the human resources component and the respective inherent running costs is as per the attached detailed budget (please refer to annex 3). Other potential budget items will result from the discussions and conclusions of the data cleaning workshop to be conducted during the period 28<sup>th</sup> May to 02<sup>nd</sup> June 2018.
