



**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**  
**concerning funding of Resident Coordinator Office sharing between**  
**Resident Coordinator Office (RCO) and un agencies, programmes, funds and**  
**offices (hereinafter the "agencies")**

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**I. PURPOSE OF THE MOU**

The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding [MOU] is to establish the terms and conditions between RCO and UN Agencies for the funding of resident office strengthening of capacity:

1. Peace and Development Advisor services
2. OMT training on Delivering as One

**II. SCOPE**

The MOU shall be the basis for funding commitments and transactions incidental to the services provided.

Subsequent arrangements and commitments may be added as a result of periodic review as provided in paragraph IV. Such additional arrangement and/or commitments will be documented, sequentially numbered and signed by parties to this MOU and attached to this document as an integral part.

**III. EFFECTIVE DATE AND PERIOD OF AGREEMENT**

This MOU is effective **01 august 2015** and shall remain in effect up to and including **31 July 2016**, subject to the availability of the services and the funding, or until the result of any periodic review [see Paragraph IV] recommends termination.

**IV. PERIODIC REVIEW**

This MOU is subject to review at any time upon written request of any party, but shall be reviewed on an annual basis in order to:

1. Determine the need for continuation, modification or termination of the agreement;
2. Make adjustments in any of the areas covered in the terms of this agreement, which includes the means of reimbursement; and
3. Verify present costs and provide projected costs at the beginning of the fourth quarter for the next fiscal year.

**V. OBLIGATIONS**

RCO agrees that sufficient staffing; property and logistic resources are available to provide with UN Agencies with the specified services.

UN Agencies agree that funds equal to the projected costs for services will be paid in advance on an annual

basis during the first two weeks of august.

UN Agencies agree that they will pay for services provided to her, as mentioned under Paragraph II, for any period of 6 months. Thereafter any request to augment and/or decrease services will be reviewed as per Paragraph IV.

RCO agrees that he (RCO) will review any change request promptly and, to the extent possible, accommodate UN Agencies' requirements.

#### VI. RCO strengthening of capacity **CHARGES**

The annual charges set for period of August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2015 to July 31<sup>st</sup>, 2016 are \$ **250.326** and have been calculated on anticipated cost at the start of the year.

The annual common services charges for subsequent years will be established during the periodic review as per IV.3 above.

#### VII. **SERVICES INCLUDED IN COMMON SERVICES CHARGES**

The following services are taken into account when strengthening of capacity as mentioned in VI.

This MOU may be terminated, in whole or part, at the end of the year.


Should either party terminate this MOU, RCO will assist UN Agencies in the orderly transfer of services.
