The previous BCURE trainers also attended the training on second day.

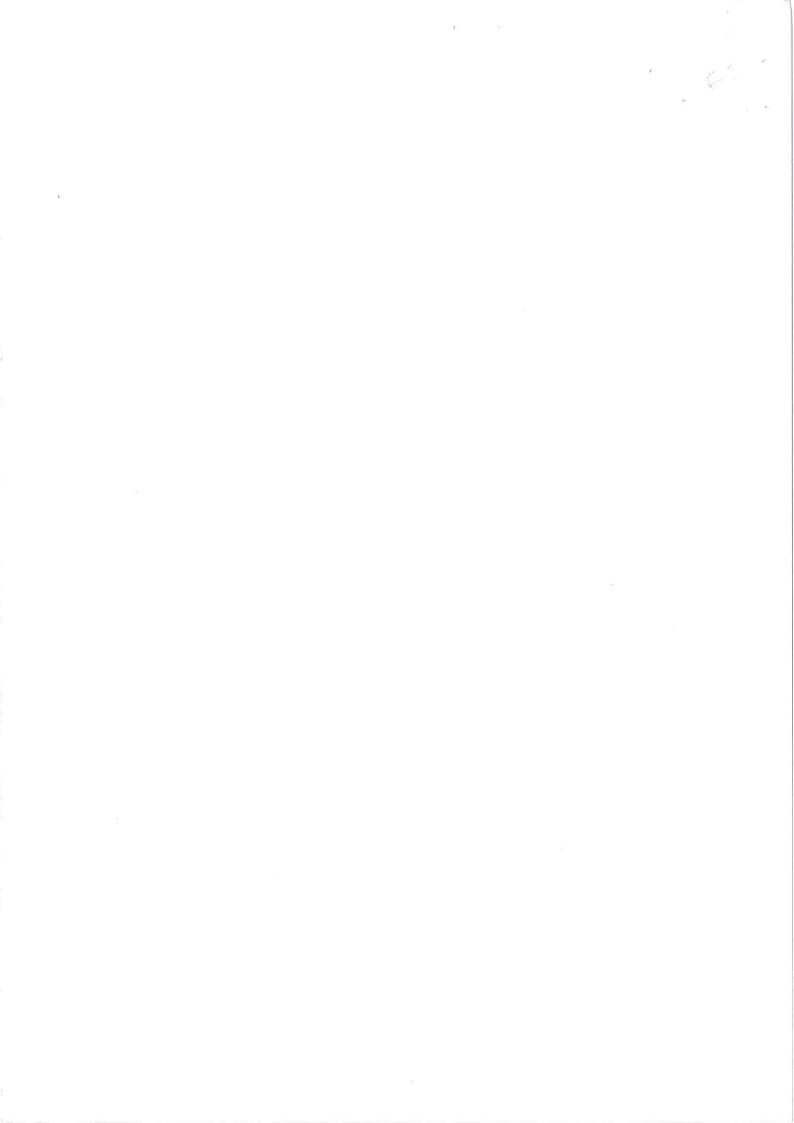



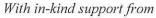
