Brief Description of Initiation Plan

The objective of this Project Preparation Grant (PPG) is to develop a full project document for a regional UNDP/GEF project in International Waters focal area addressing sustainable integrate adaptive management of water resources of the West Bering Sea large marine ecosystem in a changing climate. PPG proposal approved by the GEF Secretariat is presented in the Section II. below.

UNDP Programme Office in Russia will lead the project development process and manage the PPG budget. The PPG Atlas budget is presented in the Section III. "Total Budget and Work Plan". UNDP Office in Russia will be responsible for the selection and recruitment of PPG consultants (local and international), arranging travel and meetings, maintaining project disbursements, regular financial reporting to UNDP. PPG Steering Committees will be established to review and endorse PPG outcomes. Existing national and regional institutional arrangements will be utilized as much as possible for this purpose.

PPG Inception workshop will be conducted during first 2 months of the PPG implementation. The purpose of the PPG Inception workshop will be to introduce all partners, to plan for the project preparation activities, to review the TORs for key experts/consultants and analyze information gaps, to agree on the project coordination mechanisms.

Describe the PPG activities and justifications: The objective of the PPG is to prepare the groundwork and identify knowledge gaps essential for the scoping and formulation of the Full-Sized Project (FSP). Project preparation activities will be needed for the following purposes: Baseline identification, assessment and agreement on priority TB issues.; Baseline assessment of current climate change adaptation measures, including preliminary assessment of impacts and adaptation needs; Inventory of national scientific data collection and research capacities in natural resources and climate change; Preliminary analysis of current national policy, legal and institutional capacity in LME, ICM and ecosystem-based management to determine scope, budget and timeframe for targeted joint regional interventions; Identification and involvement of major national and regional stakeholders through a preliminary stakeholder analysis and involvement plan; Reach agreement among government, partners and stakeholders on the details, budget and allocation of co-financing for targeted demonstration projects, including the Marine Electronic Highway for the Bering Sea and Bering Straits, (jointly with IMO), fisheries management and ICM demos and environmental awareness and education programmes; Reach agreement on the overall project scope, components, outcomes, and outputs. This will require various stakeholder consultions in the project countries, specialist expert advice, and dialogue with donors and partners for the securing of co-funding and decision on final allocations to components/activities.
