Project Summary

The program will contribute to the consolidation of the Universal Social Protection System and the strategic policies for poverty reduction, gender inequality and social inclusion in El Salvador, through interventions that will: i) strengthen the national capacities for the measurement of poverty and the capacities for the design, monitoring and evaluation of poverty reduction strategies (multidimensional poverty component); ii) strengthen the income generating strategies of Comunidades Solidarias (income generating component); iii) promote the adoption of risks management and climate change adaptation practices by communities and local governments (risk management and climate change adaptation component); iv)strengthen the national capacities for the identification of participants of the poverty reduction strategies and the promotion of a rights based approach (consolidation of Comunidades Solidarias component)

The multidimensional poverty component will: a) support the revision and strengthening of the statistics institutional framework related to the measurement of poverty and the evaluation of social programs, b) develop a methodology for measuring poverty in a multidimensional manner, c) produce a multidimensional poverty indicator at the municipal level.

The income generating component will include three activities: a) the design and adaptation of methodologies and tools for income generating in Comunidades Solidaras, b) capacity building in the methodologies, c) implementing the income generating model in Comunidades Solidarias

The risk management and climate change adaptation component will: a) promote and strengthen community level organizations for the reduction of risks and adaptation to climate change, b) implement demonstrative projects, managed by communities, for the reduction of risks and adaptation to climate change, c) build capacities in government institutions in order to adopt risk reduction and climate change adaptation practices

The consolidation of Comunidades Solidarias component will a) strengthen the Registro Único de Participantes (participants' registry), as a key element for the identification and adequate targeting of social programs, b) support the inclusion of a rights based approach through systems of information and capacity building, c) strengthen the Technical Secretariat of the Presidency and the knowledge management of Comunidades Solidarias in order to promote continuous improvements in the poverty alleviation strategies

The implementation of the project will rely on the coordination of the agencies of the United Nations System and their ability to add value based on their relative comparative advantage.
