

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
Brief Description

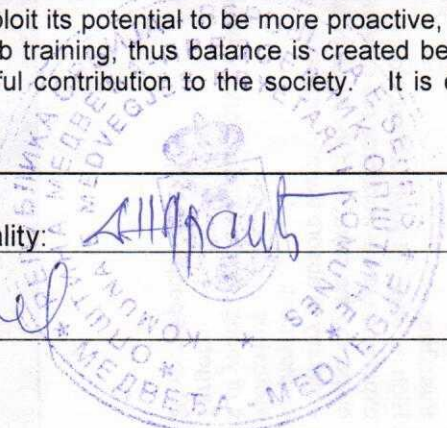
The statistical analysis shows that unemployment rate among young people is rising across Europe, reaching the percentage of more than 40% of those unemployed in several EU countries. In Serbia, the youth unemployment rate (for the young people whose age ranges between 25 and 29 years) is 35.6%, whereby our country exceeds the rate of unemployed young people in most of the neighboring countries.

There are many reasons behind the problem of youth unemployment in South Serbia such as lack of specific employable skills, weak educational system, mismatch between education and needs of the labor market and structural lack of working places. Consequently, being a graduate even from a reputable university with high grades is not a guarantee that young people will get a job or internship. Municipality of Medvedja faces the same problem, having in mind the rising number of young people in the working population.

The Municipality of Medvedja and UNDP aim to motivate and encourage young people in the municipality of Medvedja to exploit its potential to be more proactive, to maximally engage in their new tasks, be exposed to on the job training, thus balance is created between their own quality of life as well as towards their meaningful contribution to the society. It is expected that in 2018, some 20- young people will be engaged.
