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Brief Description

The Project will contribute to the rural competitiveness and higher productivity of targeted regions and accelerate impact and resource allocation of existing financial instruments. It is consistent with national priorities, strategic documents and plans, namely with: Strategy for Agriculture and Rural Development 2014-2024, National Programme for Agriculture 2018-2020, National Programme for Rural Development 2018-2020 and National Priorities for Development Assistance 2014-2020.

Component 1 will determine the appropriate allocation and quality of public spending to foster agricultural and rural economic growth, employment creation, and poverty reduction and at the same time provide practical solutions related to cultivation of berries, as well as storage and processing capacities that will ensure impact parameters for different investments at the sub-national level. This Component will be implemented in coordination with the Department for Rural Development. This component has been finalised in 2020.

Component 2 will focus on identifying the state-owned abandoned land that represents a great potential for new investments and development of agriculture sector primarily in the part dealing with organic production. Furthermore, it will assess the potential and identify areas for afforestation in AP Vojvodina for the purpose of introducing shelter belts. Component 2 will be implemented in coordination with the Directorate for Agricultural Land.

Total amount of resources for 2021 is decreased for 419.98 USD from the amount in the revised project Document cover page, due to reflection of UNORE rate. Financing documents and revised Project Document cover page were signed in October 2021, while the funds have been processed in November 2021.
