### **Challenges, risks and opportunities**

- Political instability in the region
- Increasing political tensions in Western Balkans can lead to instability, polarization and radicalization. (RWC project shall contribute to stabilization & dialogue)
- Low DRR Capacity level at CO level and weak gender mainstreaming in DRR programmes at both CO and regional levels
- Weak government support for counter-radicalization measures
- High maintenance partnerships (EC, UNISDR, etc.)
- UNDP's PVE 'development-centric' approach coordinated with DPA (CTITF) approach



### **Challenges, risks and opportunities**

- Support meaningful conflict-sensitive and long-term developmental programming through the tried and tested ABD and CBM models in areas of protracted conflict
- Continued need expressed for analytical support from IRH;
- Need for national capacities for conflict prevention to be supported;
- Need to innovate in crisis prevention accessible for Country Offices.
- Need for National Disaster Reduction Advisors including gender specialists in most disaster prone countries.
