Brief Description
 The Syria crises has resulted in significant impacts on the Syrian economy and translated into negative forms in the socio-economic situation, increasing the unemployment rate which is higher among youth unemployment. It is characterized in: unstable labour market with massive loss of jobs between demand and supply of labour is prominent. While many organizations provide various types of livelihoods, access to decent job opportunities and marketable skills and training for the start-ups and entrepreneurs is still limited. On the other hand, the labour market does not respond to the emerging needs and challenges due to lack of capacity to conduct a real-time analysis of labour market information. 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
