### Context and Priorities

#### Context and Lessons Learned

Le CO doit faire un arbitrage et s'assurer de l'alignement de toutes les activités des Plans de travail sur les produits du CPAP, tout en étant assez flexible pour prendre en compte les nouvelles priorités du Gouvernement qui surviennent au cours du cycle.

Le besoin de données sur les produits ainsi que sur les effets est important pour non seulement un meilleur ciblage et alignement du CPD sur le SP mais également pour le suivi et l'évaluation de sa mise en œuvre.

Le calendrier politique doit être intégré dans la programmation dès le début du cycle.

L'adhésion et l'engagement des populations riveraines des aires protégées est une condition sine qua non pour la réussite des projets de préservation des ressources de l'environnement. Le passif sociologique et politique doit être pris en compte dans la mise en œuvre.

#### Programmatic Priorities

Pour 2016, le BP va poursuivre l'édification du cadre global de planification et de suivi des politiques de développement en prenant en compte les nouvelles orientations nationales et mondiales.

Un accent particulier sera mis sur la finalisation de la vision 2030 qui a déjà été soutenue par le BP en 2013 et 2014.

Le BP va également lancer la revue de la SCAPE en vue de la formulation d'un nouveau programme de développement à moyen terme pour la période 2018-2023 et appuyer la mise en place d'une base statistique crédible pour le suivi de l'emploi formel et informel et l'efficacité des politiques de l'emploi.

La vulgarisation des ODD sera aussi poursuivie, avec une 1ère revue pour le forum de haut niveau.

D'autre part, les initiatives suivantes seront poursuivies :

- Appuyer l'opérationnalisation du programme national de renforcement des capacités et de modernisation de l'Etat pour le développement durable.
- Poursuivre l'appui au processus de décentralisation et le soutien aux microréalisations communautaires et populations résilientes aux changements climatiques.
- Poursuivre le soutien à l'accès des groupes vulnérables aux services juridiques et juridictionnels aux groupes vulnérables (les jeunes et les femmes), la mise en place et l'opérationnalisation de la stratégie nationale de finance inclusive en faveur des groupes les plus démunis.
- Continuer la formulation d'une infrastructure durable de paix au Togo.
- Poursuivre l'appui à la réduction de la pauvreté et la réduction des inégalités sociales à la travers la formulation et la mise en œuvre d'un Programme d'Urgence de Développement Communautaire (PUDC) en étroite collaboration avec le gouvernement

#### Organizational Priorities

Au plan opérationnel, le BP envisage le renforcement de ses capacités financières, humaines en vue d'assurer la continuité de l'efficacité et une meilleure efficience des interventions programmatiques du bureau. Le BP accentuera également la rationalisation de ses interventions, le contrôle de l'assurance qualité et un suivi plus rigoureux du reporting.

Pour la mise en œuvre du PUDC, le bureau fera appel à des collègues d'autres CO et du RSC Addis et de la Sub regional plateform de Dakar pour appuyer le bureau en attendant la mise en place d'une Unité de Gestion du Programme.

#### Priorities to Contribute to a Strong and Coherent UNCT

1. Le PNUD et l'UNFPA co-lead le Groupe inter-agence Genre, mis en place par l'Equipe de pays qui a décidé d'adopter une approche conjointe et coordonnée en appui au Gouvernement sur le questions en matière genre. Un PTA de programme/projet conjoint sera développé à cet effet au cours du premier trimestres 2016.

2. A la fermeture du Bureau du HCDH au Togo, l'Equipe de pays a repris le Centre d'information et de documentation sur les Droits de l'Homme et la Paix de Sokodé et convenu de faire du CIDDHP une entrée pour développer un programme conjoint sur les droits de l'Homme et la prévention des conflits au cours de 2016.
