Political parties accepted results. The Administrative Court confirmed all preliminary results announced by ISIE. (Achieved) 2.2 The project contributed to the delivery of trainings on candidate nomination for presidents and members of electoral regional authorities, legal officers, and ISIE's Call Centre. Project advisors also contributed to trainings held by IFES for regional coordinators. 
