Brief Description:

The Project at hand aims to support the endeavors of the Government of Turkey within the scope of the justice reform in the country for legally empowered citizens who have enhanced access to justice. To this end, since mid-2010, the project activities with regards to the needs assessment on legal empowerment and public legal education have been realized. Due to the delay in the signature process of the project document, the general elections in 2011, and the changes in the structuring of the Ministry of Justice, the project activities that were planned to be conducted in 2011 were postponed to 2012.

The budget revision at hand is for the extension in project duration from 2 to 3 years. The Project will be completed in December 2012. The budget lines for 2012 is detailed in attached 2012 Annual Work Plan.
