Brief Description:

The Project aims to create an enabling environment and empower the Prime Ministry Inspection Board for effective implementation of the newly introduced national strategy and action plan on anti-corruption. To this end, in December 2010, the project activities started with the awareness raising activities and capacity assessment concerning the anti-corruption preventive functions of Prime Ministry Inspection Board (PMIB). The gap analysis for the effective implementation of the anti-corruption strategy was postponed to late 2011 since the responsive working groups under the relevant institutions established 6 months later than it was planned. Therefore, the project activities were delayed to 2012. It is expected that the change management strategy for PMIB, the policy recommendations or the possible restructuring of the PMIB will be completed until the end of 2012.
