Project Issues


The start date of the project is September 2012 as seen in the signed project document. The first activity which is the launch of the call for proposal was scheduled to be in September 2012. 2 rounds of call for proposals was planned and finalization of the second round is estimated to be around May 2015.

However due to agenda of the project partners, the activities started in January 2013, launch of the call for proposal was made in late February 2013. The finalization of the two rounds of support fund is estimated to be finalized by September 2015 instead of May 2015. Project amendment from May 2015 to September 2015 is foreseen unless any other changes made.

Progress	Aiming to support small sized sustainable tourism projects whose durations are between 6-12 months, project partners determined the award amount as 15.000TL in minimum and 90.000TL in maximum for the year 2014 and the guideline is prepared and announced accordingly. After the call for proposal and administrative and technical evaluation period 3 project proposals were selected to be supported through the fund scheme.
	Briefly evaluation process is as follows; The online application to call for proposal which began on 27 February 2013 has ended on 22 April 2013 and 232 official concept notes for proposal out of 252 online

applications were received within this period from 62 provinces countrywide. The distribution of 252 online applications is by provinces is given in the below map.



Opening and Administrative Check

In the first phase of the evaluation, an administrative check was conducted based on the criteria defined in the guideline and 174 of 232 applications were evaluated as eligible for further technical evaluation.

Technical Evaluation and Pre-selection

These 174 concept notes, having respected the deadline and satisfied the criteria mentioned above were technically evaluated by the project team as well as by six independent accessors and were given an overall score out of 50 points in accordance with the breakdown provided in Technical Evaluation form. First 10 Concept Notes which have been given the maximum scores and meeting the criteria of having minimum 35 points were pre-selected. These shortlisted concept notes are as follows including the name of the project, the applicant organization and the city/project site respectively:

Notification of Shortlisted Applicants and Invitation to STSF Workshop on Project Development and Sustainable Tourism

These shortlisted concept notes given above were announced at the official website of Future is in Tourism, www.gelecekturizmde.com on May 20th and at the same time acception and rejection letters were sent to all applicants by e-mail through the same website.

Two representatives from each shortlisted projects were invited to a 2 days Workshop on Project Development and Sustainable Tourism, which was held in Istanbul on 29-30 May 2013 with the participation of Anadolu Efes, Ministry of Culture and Tourism and UNDP representatives.

During this Workshop, the shortlisted applicants had the opportunity to represent their projects and meet with the other applicants, share their questions about final proposal procedures, discuss the project management and sustainability processes and receive training on sustainable tourism and project development.

Submission and Evaluation of Final Project Proposals

After the completion of the workshop, in light of these information provided, the applicants had to review their projects and submit their proposals to UNDP until June 19th, 2013 in a sealed envelope by registered mail.

Administrative Control of Final Project Proposals

With the expiry of the duration given for final application, an administrative control was conducted. Thus, all 10 shortlisted applicants were evaluated as eligible for further technical evaluation.

Technical Evaluation of Final Project Proposals

Based on the following criteria, implementing partners evaluated the Final Project Proposals through the following criteria; *Applicants Capacity, Rationale, Methodology, Impact, Sustainability* and they were given an overall score out of 100 in accordance with the set of criteria defined in the guideline. As a result, the proposals scored under 70 were eliminated where the budget of those who were found to be technically eligible (scoring higher than 70) were ranked according to their respective scores.

With the participation of representatives from Anadolu Efes, Ministry of Culture and Tourism and UNDP, the Assessment Committee gathered in Istanbul on 11 July 2013 and evaluated projects those have been found to be technically eligible and analyzed their strengths and risks as well as the overall scoring.

Site Visits and Final Evaluation

Between 17-28 July 2013, representatives of UNDP and Anadolu Efes made site visits to the first five of preselected projects and three of them were found to be positive and acceptable where the remaining two projects did not meet the expectations.

Consequently, within the scope of STSF, it was agreed to select the three projects listed below and Micro-Capital Grant Agreements were signed with the following:

- 1. 100% Misia Nilüfer Misi Village Women Culture and Solidarity Association Bursa, Misi Village
- 2. Creation of Sustainable Tourism Enterprises in Mardin Under The Leadership of Women-Foundation For the Support of Women's Work Mardin
- 3. Seferihisar's Slow Food Hıdırlık Agricultural Development Cooperative İzmir, Seferihisar

Micro-Capital Grant Implementation and Monitoring Guideline

The guideline was prepared and announced following the signature of the agreements in September 2013.

By the end of 2013 100% Misia - Nilüfer Misi Village Women Culture and Solidarity Association and Seferihisar's Traditional Food - Hıdırlık Agricultural Development Cooperative Projects received their first and second tranche payments. Creation of Sustainable Tourism Enterprises in Mardin Under The Leadership of Women- Foundation For the Support of Women's Work project received only the first tranche of payment

The organizations submitted solicitation documents, contractual documents and all supporting documents for proof of the expenditures. Both the financial and technical progress monitored by UNDP Project team. Due to shift in the launch of the project and call for proposal, the fund scheme started in September 2013 and finalization of the first scheme of support fund is estimated to be in
