Brief Description

The **Governance Beyond Recovery. Responding to Strengthen Ukraine's Resilience in the Face of COVID-19 Epidemic (RESURFACE)** Project builds on **(a)** approaches tested in the weeks following Ukraine's initial exposure to the pandemic through the UNDP Crisis Coordination and Management in Ukraine (CCMU) Project, **(b)** results of the high-level dialogue between the UNDP Administrator and the Minister of Foreign Affairs in the summer of 2020, and **(c)** in-depth dialogue between government counterparts that received initial support from UNDP as the pandemic started affecting Ukraine. The RESURFACE Project will work to **(1)** support internal (Office of the Prime Minister / SCMU) and external (MFA) crisis coordination capacity and **(2)** extract replicable lessons learned from institutional crisis adaptation to be replicated by other government entities for better performance and resilience (Ministry of Culture and Information Policy). The Project will also have three themes that penetrate all activities: **(a)** gender equality and strengthening protections for the most vulnerable first, leaving no one behind; **(b)** information security and strong communications that go well beyond immediate project priorities; **(c)** digital transformation culture and eliciting approaches that may further transform Ukraine's governance bodies, even as the in-country epidemic subsides (Ministry of Digital Transformation).
