**UNDAF (OR EQUIVALENT) OUTCOME INVOLVING UNDP:** By 2022, the vulnerable population is resilient to climate change and disaster risk, with sustainable and inclusive production, planning and management of the territory, cities, natural resources and the environment.

**UNDP Strategic Plan Signature Solution on Energy:** Increasing energy access for those furthest behind and accelerating the transition to renewable energy.

Implementing Parties: UNDP.

## **Brief Description**

The project seeks to support the establishment of the adequate condition at the country-level to attract investments to close the energy access gap. These will complement UNDP and partner activities on energy access, financing, and stakeholder engagement. CO will use TRAC 2 Funds in order to enhance Energy Access in Angola, which currently stands at 42.7%, leaving an estimated 18,909,000 persons without access to clean and affordable energy.

Resources from TRAC 2, will enable the Country Office (CO) to:

- Identify and advance opportunities that contribute to UNDP Strategic Plan and Africa Promise objectives on Energy.
- Enhance capacities of key national partners contributing to closing the energy access gap and a transition to a low-carbon energy future, contributing to National Development Plan targets of energy access to 50% by 2022.
- Electrify Off-grid communities with renewable energy sources to enable sustainable livelihood and economic growth.
- Strengthen and create, female led, small scale businesses opportunities and cooperatives by providing renewable energy solutions.
