





<p>New laws on Environmental Protection, Environmental Impact Assessment and on Waste Management have been approved, and the National Strategy for Waste Management has been prepared, together with Regional Waste Management Plans for three regions. There is no procedure yet in place for the management and control of landfills and uncontrolled dumpsites.</p> <p>The United Nations agencies will support solid waste management at local level, and green jobs will be promoted in waste management and environmental protection. Further support will continue through the implementation of the National Cleaner Production Programme.</p>
