Monitoring & Evaluation Summary

In addition to the monitoring missions undertaken by UNDPs CO and the RCU, an independent audit was conducted which indicated that the financial transactions were in-keeping with the project expectations and UNDP financial disbursement procedures. The project experienced a budget over run of >\$200.

Site visits and participation in local and national meetings revealed a high level of participation by stakeholders and full national /government support and involvement.

Status of Equipment Purchased:

No equipment was purchased under this project. The funds were used to procure the services of consultants (national and International) to develop the project proposal to meet the standards of the GEF.

Comments: The project encountered some hitches and delays but in the end the proposal was submitted in time for the GEF review and was approved with minimal concerns or comments.

The resulting SIRMM project was approved by the GEF CEO in August 2007.
