

Project #82884 – PIMS 4419 FSP Landscape approach to management of peatlands aiming at multiple ecological benefits

Status

Update

Field research of the reserved SNPAs (the most significant peatlands) is conducted with the aim of their further announcement as local reserves on a total area of 13000 ha. Graphic maps are prepared. Land use transformation from plowing to sustainable meadow cultivation were completed on the territory of 200 ha in two agrienterprises in Bereza district. Pilot activities on testing method of deep plowing on shallow peat soils with creation of sand-mixing culture were conducted in the territory of 10 ha in Luminets district. Lida Forestry completed works on planting black alder on the area of 100 ha. Soil has been prepared on the selected planting sites. Black alder trees are planted. Necessary technical activities are conducted during the first year after the planting.
