Based on the signed contribution between UNDP and the Government of the Netherlands dated 3 December 2019, I am pleased to inform you that USD 100,000 is allocated to the project Support for Equality and Justice (project ID 00112206; output 00110829). Funding has been made available from the *Global Programme on Strengthening the Rule of Law and Human Rights for Sustaining Peace and Fostering Development* through the UNDP Funding Window for Governance, Conflict Prevention and Resilience, sub-window on Conflict Prevention and Sustaining Peace (ATLAS fund code 28623; donor code 00182).
