**AMENDMENT
TO THE SUB-RECIPIENT AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE UNITED NATIONS DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME
AND NATIONAL TUBERCULOSIS PROGRAM PAKISTAN FOR A PROJECT
FUNDED BY THE GLOBAL FUND TO FIGHT AIDS, TUBERCULOSIS AND
MALARIA**

WHEREAS, the United Nations Development Program (“UNDP”) and **National TB Control Program Pakistan** (“Sub-recipient” or “SR”) (together referred to as the “Parties”) entered into a Sub-recipient agreement, dated 27 March 2019 (the “SR Agreement”).

WHEREAS, in accordance with Article XXVI of the SR Agreement, requiring that the SR Agreement and/or its Annexes may be modified or amended only by written agreement between the Parties, the Parties now wish to amend the SR Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements contained herein, the Parties hereby agree to amend the SR Agreement as follows:




1. The existing face sheet to the SR Agreement is replaced with the face sheet attached hereto.
