## RE: REQUEST FOR NO COST EXTENSION OF THE ENERGY-BASED RURAL ELECTRIFICATION PROGRAMME FOR BOTSWANA 0 PIMS 1771, ATLAS PROJECT NO. 000039468

Further to the evaluation of the above project last year and the consideration of the attached evaluation report which was approved by the Steering Committee meeting, during which it was approved that the project be extended for two years with no additional costs. We are pleased to request for your consideration and approval to extend the project up to 31st December 2013.

The project is extended because it has not been able to achieve the set objectives owing to a late start and inadequate project .management including project oversight by UNDP. The Government of Botswana, the Botswana Power Corporation and UNDP have recommitted themselves during the Steering Committee meeting of 10<sup>th</sup> June 2011 to rededicate their efforts in ensuring successful implementation of the project.
