Brief Description

The CMP Multi-Donor project aims to complement a larger EU funded and UNDP implemented programme of support to the Committee on Missing Persons in Cyprus.

Support to the Committee on Missing Persons' Project on Exhumation, Identification and Return of Remains of Missing Persons in Cyprus was handed over from UNDP Bratislava Regional Centre to UNDP-Partnership for the Future Programme in Cyprus in July 2011 (today UNDP PMO in Cyprus).
