Brief Description

This program's goal is to increase the likelihood of reaching a comprehensive settlement to the Cyprus problem by delivering timely and flexible support to the UN entities directly engaged in the peace process – UN Good Offices Mission (OSASG), UN Peacekeeping Force in Cyprus (UNFICYP), and the Committee on

Missing Persons (CMP). Specific support would include specialized advice and assistance to the leaders and negotiators in the peace talks, providing analysis and technical information to increase participants' awareness of the political and security context in which the negotiations are taking place, and advice to both sides as they plan implementation of a potential agreement during the fall of 2016 and into early 2017 – all under the auspices and direction of the UN entities in Cyprus.

To accomplish this, the program's objectives are:

- 1. Support UN Good Offices' and UNFICYP's efforts to provide facilitation, implementation planning, and overall peace process support through the provision of relevant advisors and subject matter experts.
- 2. Support the UN's efforts to increase Cypriot confidence in the peace process by providing the Committee for Missing Persons in Cyprus (CMP) with an archives coordinator to review classified and declassified UN documents pertaining to the ongoing search for missing persons.
