Brief Description

The 2015 Annual Work Plan (AWP) was prepared in line with the new Strategic Partnership Cooperation Framework (SPCF) 2013-2016, signed on 28 January 2013 between the Government of the State of Eritrea (GoSE) and the United Nations System in Eritrea as well as the Country ProgrammeAction Plan (CPAP) signed on 28 March 2013 between the GoSE and the UNDP to enhance the well-being of the people of Eritrea, particularly the vulnerablepopulation. The SPCF is aligned with the national development priorities as articulated through GoSE sector plans, strategies and policies for the period 2013 - 2016; and with internationally agreed Goals including the MDGs. Accordingly, the AWP focuses on enhancing access to safe and environmentally sustainable water supply for agriculture and domestic uses. With this AWP, some xxx households will be supported and activities therein are expected to be implemented from February - December 2015. If the allocated amount could not be fully utilized as planned, any remaining balance will be reallocated on time to other components so as not to lose the funds.
