Mr. Denis Baptiste, the 4 H coordinator, introduced and welcomed the UNDP ICCAS team to the participants. An Estimate of 49 persons representing CBO'S, NGO's, Grassroots organizations, as well as some innovators were present from the St Patrick's area.

Mr. Barriteau then presented a 20 minute overview of the climate change adaptation fund, providing details and guidance on how community groups can access this funding opportunity. The presentation also included information on Climate change and how persons are affected by the effects of our changing climate. The participants were introduced to some potential challenges that they may experience due to climate change such as landslides, rise in sea level, water shortages, and threats to marine life.

- Will the funding be grant and will this fund have to be paid back
- Can a project be eligible for more than \$50,000 USD
- Is there a limit on the number of projects that will provide funding

Participants also took the opportunity to share their ideas seeking guidance on whether their project can be considered for approval under the CCAF.
