As you are well aware, in line with its sincere engagement with the development agenda, both at the bilateral level and within the UN, Turkey shares the concerns of the Small Island Developing States (SIDS), which are confronted with unique challenges, and is committed to the success of the Third International Conference on Small Island Developing States, to be held in the Independent State of Samoa, Apia on 1-4 September 2014.

In this regard, you might recall that Turkey has in the past made financial contributions to the organization of the Interregional Preparatory Meeting in Barbados (40.000 US Dollars), to the Trust Fund for the SIDS Conference (150.000 US Dollars) as well as to the Host Government of the Independent State of Samoa (200.000 US Dollars).
