Youth Leadership Programme is a regional project that aims to empower youth to become engaged change-makers and social innovators that have the skills and resources to implement the SDGs in their communities, countries and the region.

This work plan contains planned activities for 2019 aiming at achieving YLP's three outputs, which will be realized through a portfolio of diverse and innovative approaches that will allow the programme to grow and broaden its horizon by engaging more young women and men in the region. By bringing in new vision, YLP will develop new learning tools, facilitate knowledge sharing through physical and virtual platforms and look towards new partnerships. As part of YLP cycle 5, UNDP will partner with youth-serving organizations in countries across the Arab region to host national activities designed to support and empower a diverse set of young women and men change-makers, as they design, implement and scale innovative, impactful and sustainable development solutions. In addition, two regional events will be held to launch and support the programme, bringing together youth, youth-serving organizations, policy makers and relevant stakeholders from across the region.


