STANDARD LETTER OF AGREEMENT

1. 5. The relevant provisions of the [Insert title and date of the UNDP standard basic assistance agreement with the Government] (the "SBAA") or the Supplemental Provisions forming part of the project document, including the provisions on liability and privileges and immunities, shall apply to the provision of such support services. The NACO shall retain overall responsibility for the nationally managed projects through its Implementing Partner. The responsibility of the UNDP country office for the provision of the support services described herein shall be limited to the provision of such support services detailed in the annex to the project document.

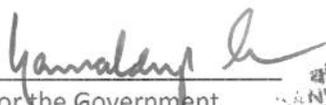

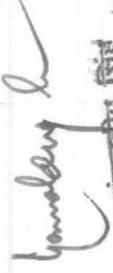
