Brief Description

This project was developed in response to a request by the Government of Jamaica for the UN to provide technical and financial support to the coordination of the process of the establishment and operationalization of the Commission of Enquiry. The objective of this project is for the Commission of Enquiry to be credible and to positively contribute to bringing closure to the Tivoli Gardens 2010 events and to enhance social dialogue around key issues in Jamaican society. This is closely linked to a broader Community Safety and Social Cohesion Programme for which preparatory work will be conducted as part of this project.

The outputs of the project are:

- 1. The Ministry of Justice has the necessary capacity for the establishment and effective functioning of the neutral and transparent Commission of Enquiry
- 2. The public awareness on principles and operating assumptions on COE's strengthened and information sharing mechanisms on the commission of enquiry supported.
