**Brief Description**

The United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) works with people at all levels of society to help build nations that can withstand crisis and drive and sustain the kind of growth that improves the quality of life for everyone. Fostering Resilience is at the heart of this approach to promote sustainable development. One of the hazards that is inhibiting sustainable development is drought. For many months Kenya, has been experiencing the impacts of droughts triggered by climate variability. The proposed project aims to build the capacities of communities, and government through the concerted effort of the United Nations system and bilateral partners.

This project has two main objectives: first to scale up the coordination and response capacities within the UN and in Government to light of the UN Flash Appeal and current humanitarian interventions. A key element of this coordination is the improvement of the humanitarian deployment, early warning, and promotion of the right partnerships to manage the drought and associated challenges such as conflicts, migration and displacements and protection. The other goal of this project is anchored on the longer-term objectives of the UNDP programme on Deepening the Governance of Disaster Risks Management and Resilience in Kenya. It seeks to adopt a resilience-focused approach which aims to address structural impediments that contribute to the vulnerability of households; while directly enabling households and communities to recover from the effects of the drought.
