Brief Description

The Northern Plains of Cambodia are the largest remaining intact block of a unique landscape of global importance for biodiversity conservation. The area is either a last refuge for over 40 species on the IUCN Red List. The CALM project is designed to address the problem of escalating biodiversity loss across the Northern Plains, caused by increasing human land and resource use. This is achieved by: (1) the introduction of biodiversity considerations into provincial level land use processes; (2) the demonstration of specific mainstreaming interventions at three key sites (including community landuse tenure, community contracts and incentives for biodiversity supportive land-use practices, as well as work to mainstream biodiversity into the forestry and tourism productive sectors); and (3) strengthen biodiversity management by the government in a Wildlife Sanctuary and a Protected Forest.
